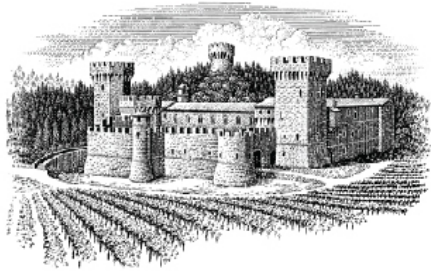
JOHN CURLEY

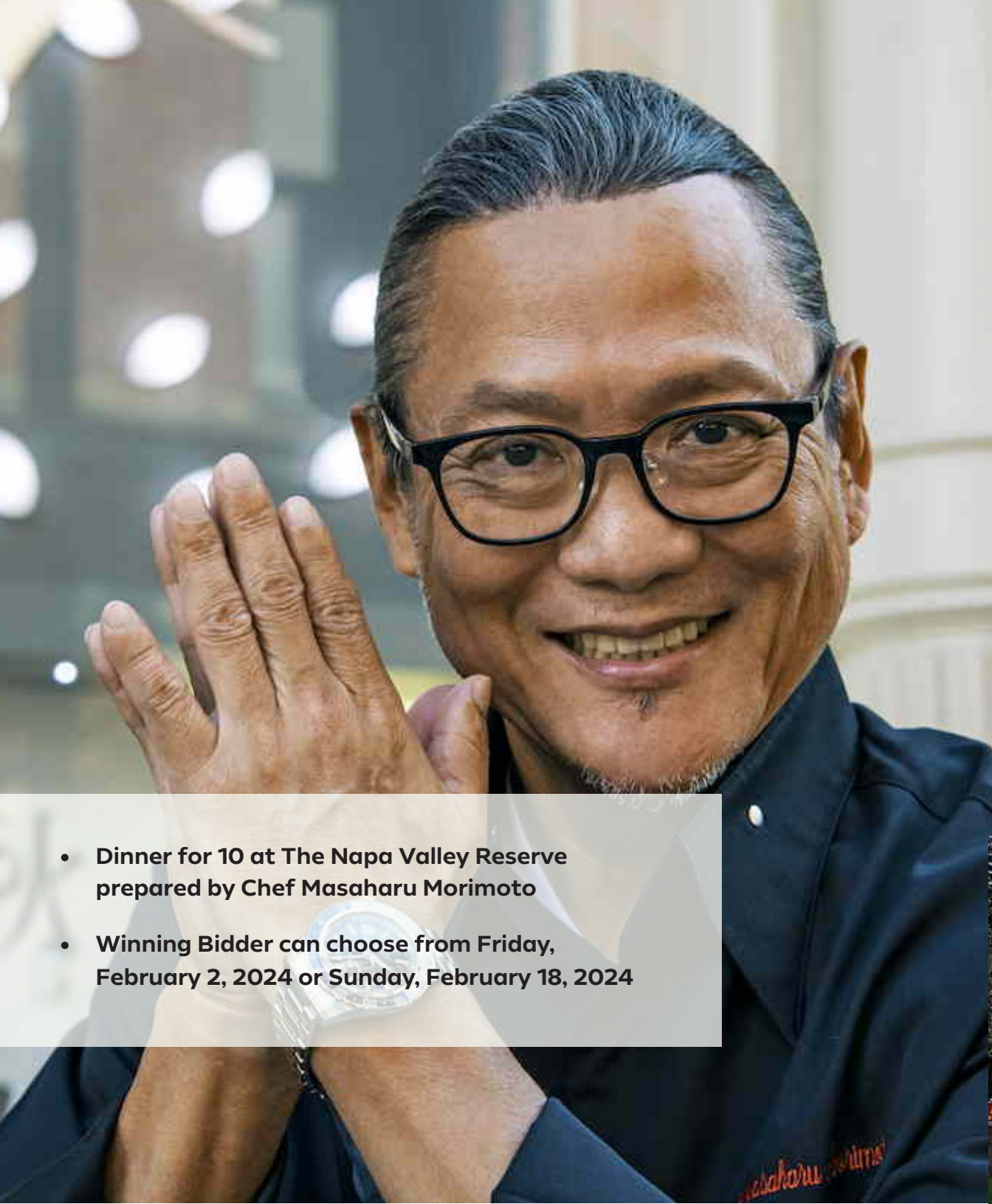

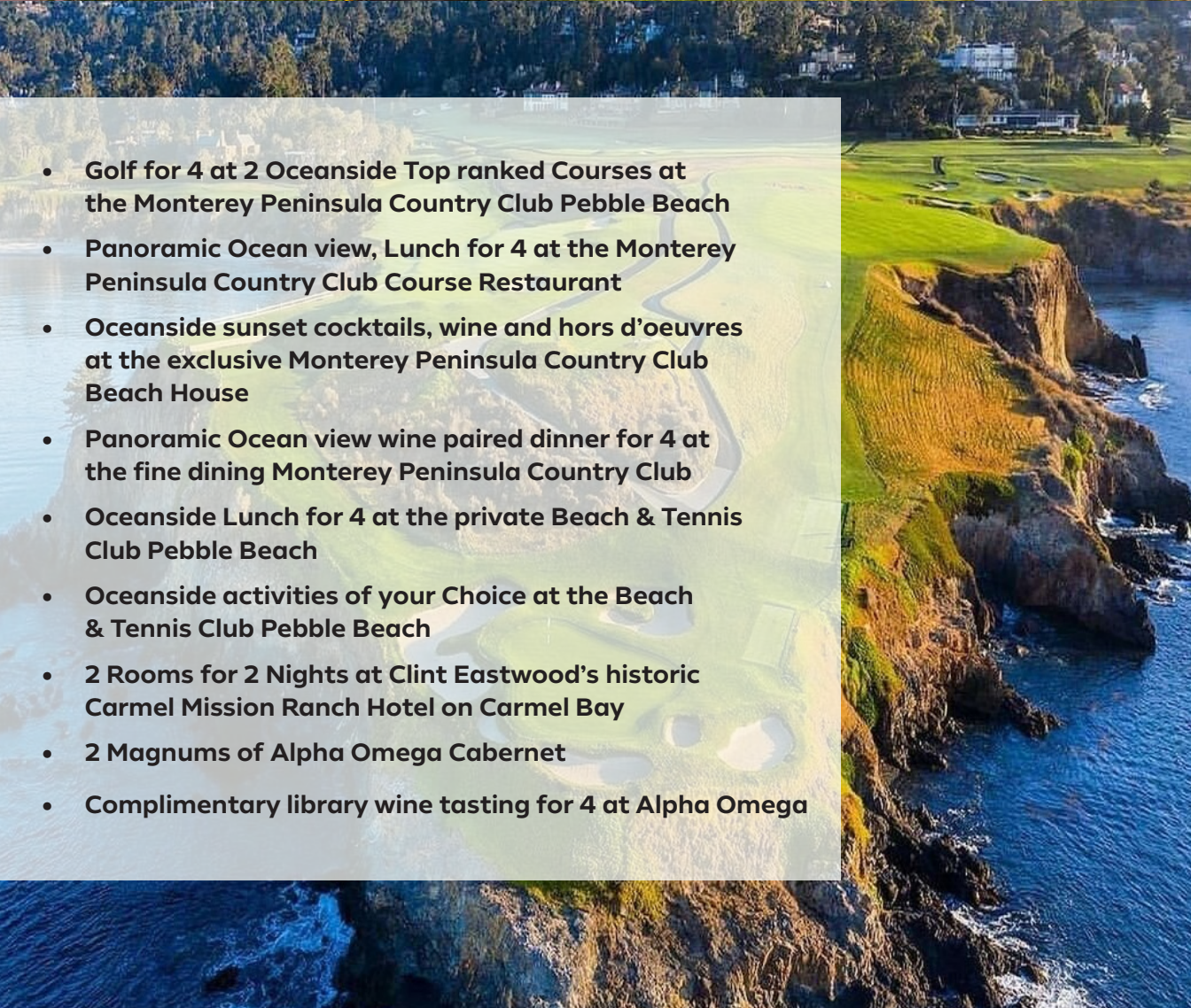

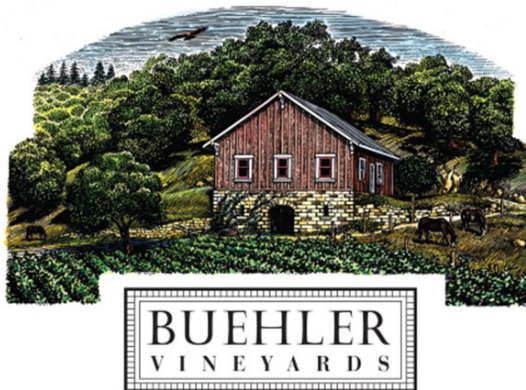
